At 5 feet 11 inches and 160 pounds, no one could hardly believe that George Selby, also known as “The Kid McCoy,” could be the world's light heavyweight champion in boxing. But he was. With an incredible punch, he scored over 90 knockouts in his astonishing career.

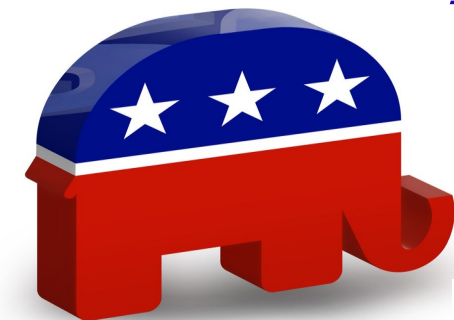
